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Dear Parents / Carers,

We would like to inform you of the behaviour policy that is followed in Reception. Reception follows the 'Good to be Green' system which is used throughout the whole school. The system is visual which enables all children to see how they are doing in class and promotes positive behaviour. The objective is to 'stay green' all day. If the children receive a yellow card and they correct their behaviour during the day, they can go back to green. If the behaviour continues the children receive a red card. Children receive a red card without a warning for violence and rudeness to an adult. Red cards are recorded through our school system which enable teachers to identify children who consistently have red cards. The teacher will work with parents to implement a behaviour strategy to support children's behaviour. Every day is a new day, so your child will start with a green card at the beginning of each day.

The children can gain gold award cards, superstar learner cards and other reward cards for good work or behaviour.

The following chart clearly shows the rewards and sanctions (stages of the 'Good to be Green' system) all staff follow to manage behaviour.
