




Characteristics of Effective Learning

<p>Playing and Exploring</p>	<p><u>Finding out and exploring</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - showing curiosity about objects, events and people - using senses to explore the world around them - engaging in open-ended activity - showing particular interests <div style="border: 2px solid orange; padding: 10px; text-align: center;"> <p>Exploring Elephant</p>  <p>I am an explorer.</p> </div>	<p><u>Playing with what they know</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - pretending objects are things from experience - representing their experiences in play - taking on a role in their play - acting out experiences with other people <div style="border: 2px solid pink; padding: 10px; text-align: center;"> <p>I Know Rhino</p>  <p>I play with what I know.</p> </div>	<p><u>Being willing to 'have a go'</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - initiating activities - seeking challenge - showing a 'can do' attitude - taking a risk, engaging in new experiences, an learning by trial and error. <div style="border: 2px solid blue; padding: 10px; text-align: center;"> <p>Go For It Gorilla</p>  <p>I will have a go.</p> </div>
<p>Active Learning</p>	<p><u>Being involved and concentrating</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - maintaining focus on their activity for a period of time - showing high levels of energy, fascination - not easily distracted - paying attention to details <div style="border: 2px solid green; padding: 10px; text-align: center;"> <p>Concentrating Crocodile</p>  <p>I join in and concentrate.</p> </div>	<p><u>Keeping on trying</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - persisting with activity when challenges occur - showing a belief that more effort or a different approach will pay off - bouncing back after difficulties. <div style="border: 2px solid red; padding: 10px; text-align: center;"> <p>Persevering Parrot</p>  <p>I keep trying.</p> </div>	<p><u>Enjoying achieving what they set out to do</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - showing satisfaction in meeting their own goals - being proud of how they accomplished something – not just the end result - enjoying meeting challenges for their own sake rather than external rewards or praise <div style="border: 2px solid teal; padding: 10px; text-align: center;"> <p>Proud Peacock</p>  <p>I am proud of what I do.</p> </div>

Creative Chameleon




I have my own ideas.
